
Autumn gives more permission to introvert, and I'm feeling this in the music I'm listening to, the outfits I'm reaching for, and the books I'm diving into.

Enjoy my take on Half-Baked Harvest's Black Widow Smash cocktail. Or, if this feels energetically incompatible with your Friday evening, pour your favourite glass of red as I often do.

2 oz tequila, Mezcal, or gin 1 handful of blackberries 1-2 sprigs rosemary 1/2 lemon, juiced 1-2 TBSP honey sugar or salt to rim glass orange bitters sparkling water

- 1. In jar or cocktail shaker, muddle berries, lemon juice, honey. Add orange bitters and tequila.
- 2. Rim glass with sugar or salt. Add ice.
- Strain drink over ice into glass, add more ice to taste, then add sparkling water.
- 4. Garnish with rosemary.




